#### **What's Included:**

Equipment - participants will have access to club equipment; bows, arrows, etc.  
 Training aids - various training tools will be used, these are included in the class fees.

**Who:** All aspiring archers. This is a shooting sport, and all students, regardless of age, must, in the opinion of the instruction staff, be able to safely and comfortably handle the equipment.

**What:** These programs are suitable for beginning and novice archers as well as those experienced archers who want to continue to work on shooting fundamentals.  
 We will be teaching archery based on the USA Archery/Team USA, National Training System (NTS). Safety and archery range rules will be the most important thing that we cover but most of our time will be spent learning about archery equipment and proper shooting form development.  
 The course is taught by Coach Mike Hanson; a [USA Archery](http://USA Archery) certified level 4 NTS archery coach and the material that we cover will serve as the foundation for a lifetime of archery.

**Where:** Classes will be held at the archery facility at the Bainbridge Island Sportsmen's Club located at: 8203 Sportsmen's Club Rd., Bainbridge Island. **Cost:** Archery Camp costs \$300.

**Payment options:** Payment can be made online or when you arrive at class. Classes must be paid for in full by the first day of class.

**Equipment:** All necessary archery equipment is provided. Or you can bring your own equipment.

**Maximum Class Size: 8** Archery classes are offered on a first-come-first-served basis, priority will be given to returning students. Classes fill up quickly but additional opportunities may be added based on demand.

**What to Wear:** Even though we shoot from a sheltered area our range is essentially an outdoor range so dress accordingly. We will have class regardless of the weather conditions. It can get chilly out there on the range. Participants should wear clothes appropriate for the season. Non-bulky, snug-fitting sleeves are preferred but please dress for the weather. Clothes must be free of large buttons, pins, badges, scarves or other things on the front that can be caught in the bow string. **Please bring something to tie back long hair.** The range is fairly level but it is dirt so it is sometimes muddy; please wear footwear that encloses the whole foot. Do not wear sandals, flip-flops, bare feet or "foot glove" type socks.

**Snacks:** Parents will be asked to provide a snack for one of the 5 days of class. It can be anything you like.
