What's Included:

Equipment - Island Archers JOAD participants will have access to club equipment but at some point JOAD archers are encouraged to consider investing high quality equipment of their own when it is appropriate.

Awards - All archers will be eligible to earn awards for achievement in the programs.

Who: All aspiring archers age 8-18 (up to age 20 for JOAD). This is a shooting sport, and all students, regardless of age, must, in the opinion of the instruction staff, be able to safely and comfortably handle the equipment.

What: We will be teaching archery based on the USA Archery/Team USA, National Training System (NTS). Safety and archery

range rules will be the most important thing that we cover but most of our time will be spent learning about archery equipment and proper shooting form development.

Island Archers JOAD participants will be working on advanced skills to achieve their individual goals.

The course is taught by Coach Mike Hanson; a [USA Archery](#) certified level 4 NTS Coach and the material that we cover will serve as the foundation for a lifetime of archery.

Where: Classes will be held at the archery facility at the Bainbridge Island Sportsmen's Club located at: 8203 Sportsmen's Club Rd., Bainbridge Island.

Equipment: All necessary archery equipment is provided. Use of non-club equipment during the class is subject the approval of the instructor. Participants need not purchase any equipment to begin their training but JOAD Archers are strongly encouraged to invest in good equipment of their own.

Maximum Class Size: Archery classes are offered on a first-come-first-served basis, priority will be given to returning students. Classes fill up quickly but additional opportunities may be added based on demand.

What to Wear: Even though we shoot from a sheltered area our range is essentially an outdoor range so dress accordingly. We will have class regardless of the weather conditions. It can get chilly out there on the range.

Participants should wear clothes appropriate for the season. Non-bulky, snug-fitting sleeves are preferred but please dress for the weather. Clothes must be free of large buttons, pins, badges, scarves or other things on the front that can be caught in the bow string. **Please bring something to tie back long hair.** The range is fairly level but it is dirt so it is sometimes muddy; please wear footwear that encloses the whole foot. Do not wear sandals, flip-flops, bare feet or "foot glove" type socks.
